— Types of Letter Series : Alphabet Series

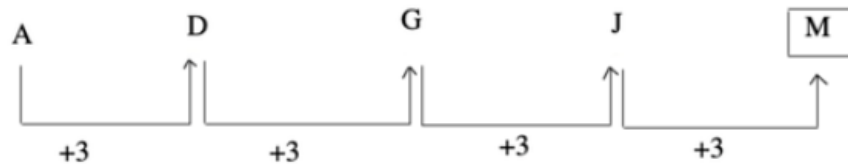
Type #1: Alphabet Series

In this type, letters of English alphabet are arranged in a particular pattern like reverse order of letters, skipping of letters, position of letters in alphabetical order etc.

Example 1: Find the next term in the series. A, D, G, J, ?

(a) K (b) L (c) M (d) N

Solution: (c) Pattern of the series is a shown below



Every next term of the series is next third letter of the alphabets (according to position).

Hence, the missing term is M.

Example 2: Find the next two terms of the given series. Z, S, W, O, T, K, Q, G, ?, ?

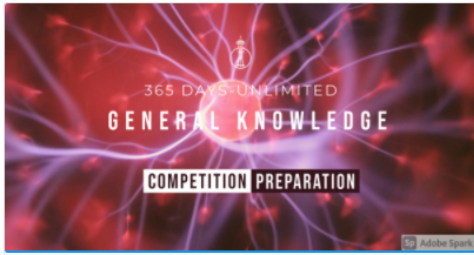

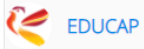

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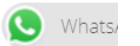

— भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था की विशेषताएँ

2020 के अनुसार भारत का कुल सकल घरेलू उत्पाद (GDP of India 2020) 3.202 ट्रिलियन डॉलर हो गया है। क्रय मूल्य शक्ति (PPP) के अनुसार भारत विश्व की तीसरी सबसे बड़ी अर्थव्यवस्था है।

कुल सकल घरेलू उत्पाद (GDP) के अनुसार आज भारत अमेरिका, चीन, जापान, जर्मनी और ब्रिटेन के बाद दुनिया की छठी सबसे बड़ी अर्थव्यवस्था बन गया है। इसमें फ्रांस जैसे शक्तिशाली देश को पीछे छोड़ दिया है।
